

Street Bridge and Airy Trestle Bridge - Some local businesses have verbally expressed interest in providing funds to help repair the Airy Trestle Bridge.

- Council felt that no additional capital road projects be budgeted for 2016. Staff to focus on completing current capital road projects.

- Installation of the new LED Street lights started today. An average of thirty street lights will be installed per day. Project will be completed in 2015.

- Ministry of Transportation has erected a stop sign on Reids Road. The current stop sign by-law should be reviewed to include the current stop signs off Provincial Highways.
- Reviewed and discussed documentation from a property owner requesting to purchase an unopened road allowance off Nipissing Road. The Committee examined maps of the area and agreed that it was not in the best interest of the township to sell the unopened road allowance at this time. Staff to advise the property owner.
- Discussion in regards to the design and location of a proposed floating dock extension to the existing dock at the Galeairy Lake boat launch. When the water is low it is very difficult to get in and out of watercrafts.
- Properties that do not have deeded/legal access will not be granted building permits until access is legally approved, as per the Township Official Plan.
- Discussion pertaining to general winter preparation such as, culvert marking and placing the wing on the grader.
