

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- Airy Landfill site trench construction will be scheduled for this year. Waiting for Ministry of Natural Resources approval.
- Discussion regarding the water conservation trench at Airy Landfill Site.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Discussion regarding the concern of large scale brush debris that has been disposed at the Landfill Sites and the costs to the Township to get rid of such large amounts. It was determined that a fee for sorted and unsorted material for commercial contractors will be as followed:

<u>Sorted</u>	<u>Unsorted</u>
- ½ ton truck/Van & small trailers \$ 5	- ½ ton truck small trailers \$ 20
- Large Trailer \$ 30	- Trailer \$ 120
- Single axle \$ 50	- Single axle \$ 200
- Tandem \$ 80	- Tandem \$ 320
- Tri-axle \$ 120	- Tri-axle \$ 500

A resolution will be brought forward to add the above fees to the Schedule of Fees By-Law # 14-460 at the next regular council meeting.

- Pictures were presented to show the current shredding operations at Lyell Landfill Site.
- Pictures were presented of the waste collection bins at Aylen Lake, Hay Lake and the former Lyell Lake areas. The pictures confirmed the health and safety issue and the non-household waste that is being disposed such as, couches, toilets and other construction material.
- It was determined with the reasons set forth by Mr. Mooder and the costs associated to apply for an Environmental Compliance Approval (ECA) and the ongoing operational costs for additional monitoring to offer the waste collection bins that the bins will be removed from all locations and a letter will be sent to the Cottage Association's. Associations' may be able to place the bins on private property as long as all Provincial regulations are met and adequate access is available for the garbage truck. The Associations will also be responsible to maintain and monitor the use of the bin. Staff will provide signs to indicated what can be disposed in the bins.
