SPRING CLEANUP SCHEDULE

Both sites will be open 8:00 am to 3:30 pm for eight consecutive Saturdays, commencing on the first **weather-permitting** Saturday in April. Please visit the website for the dates, www.southalgonquin.ca.

Household Waste Collection Areas

SUNDAY: From May 5 to October 20, the waste collection truck will be located at the Aylen Lake Boat Launch from 12:00 noon to 4:00 pm. *PLEASE NOTE: * When Monday is a holiday, pickup will be on that holiday Monday, **not** the Sunday of that week.

TUESDAY: Old 127, Hwy. 127 from the Old 127 south to the Sabine Ward including McGuey Rd, and the McKenzie Lake Rd area, returning north on Hwy 127 to Old 127. McRae-Hay Lake Rd roadside collection will begin May 7 and end October 22.

WEDNESDAY: The Village of Madawaska, Hwy 60 to the eastern boundary of the Township including Spectacle Lake Rd, Major Lake Rd and McCauley Lake Rd, Hwy 523 to the southern boundary of the Township. The waste collection truck will be located at the Aylen Lake Boat Launch from 2 pm to 3 pm.

THURSDAY: Hwy. 60 from the Village of Madawaska's western boundary to Hwy 127, south on Hwy 127 to Old 127/Hwy 127, returning north on Hwy 127 to Hwy 60, west on Hwy 60 to Whitney then the Village of Whitney including Hwy 60 to the western boundary of the Township, returning east on Hwy 60 to Madawaska.

Notice to Residents

- Please place household waste at the roadside on the scheduled day of collection. This will help deter birds and animals. (Property owners are responsible for picking up any waste that may get scattered along the roadside by birds and animals). **The time of your roadside pick-up could be anytime between 7:00 am to 3:00 pm on your scheduled day.**
- Residents are required to place household waste in garbage bags. Approved removable containers are permitted providing the household waste is in garbage bags (freezers or permanent containers are not acceptable).
- Residents, who store household waste in private bins or boxes will be required to remove the waste from these bins on the day of collection, put the waste in garbage bags and place them at the side of the nearest Township maintained road or public highway. **Private bins must be located on private property outside of the obvious road allowance.**

Transporting Waste

- Residents are required to secure and cover loads to avoid debris from falling off onto municipal roads and highways.

Community Litter Clean Up Event

Council will be hosting a community litter clean up. Additional information will be on social media, the website and around the township as plans develop.

Whether it's raccoons or some other animal, if they get into your garbage it's bound to be a mess!
Please place household waste at the roadside only on the scheduled day of collection.



At The Landfill Site, We Recycle...

ELECTRONICS

Please note that microwaves belong with the appliances.

TIRES

Tires on rims will not be accepted.

STEEL

All types of steel are accepted.

ALUMINUM

Please help by making sure deposited items are made from aluminum. Aluminum is not magnetic (for example soft drink cans and cat food cans). Please ask the Attendant for help.

APPLIANCES

All appliances are accepted. Please place fridges and freezers in a normal standing position and latching or locking doors must be removed.

SMALL BATTERIES AND CELLPHONES

Collection Kits are available at the Municipal Office and both landfill sites.

At the Landfill Site, We Divert...

CLEAN WOOD: Only brush, unpainted or untreated wood may be deposited in the brush area.

We Reduce...

SHREDDING: Most waste that is not Hazardous, Household, Clean Wood, Reusable or Recyclable may be deposited in the Shredding Pile. (No food or food packing).

FURNITURE: Fabric-covered furniture and mattresses may be deposited in the Furniture Pile.

We Reuse... Come check it out!

Each landfill site has a reuse area where useful items can be deposited or taken home.

Please see the Landfill Site Attendant prior to depositing material to ensure the proper location.

Household Hazardous Waste Day SATURDAY AUGUST 10, 2019 • 9:00 am–1:00 pm

HOW

- For your own protection, deliver the hazardous waste material labelled in the trunk of your car.
- DO NOT mix materials.
- All materials must be clearly marked.
- If the container is damaged, package the container in a plastic bag in order not to spill it during the journey to the collection site.

WHAT

- PAINTS, (flammable and toxic). Do NOT mix latex with oil base paints.
- AUTOMOTIVE BATTERIES, (corrosive and toxic). Wear rubber gloves when handling.
- HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES, disposable and rechargeable (corrosive and toxic).
- HOUSEHOLD MEDICINES/OLD PRESCRIPTIONS, (toxic) in a separate bag.
- WASTE OIL (flammable and toxic). Clearly mark the container.
- PESTICIDES, INSECTICIDES, HERBICIDES (toxic).
- POOL CHEMICALS and BLEACH (reactive and toxic). DO NOT MIX and keep separate from each other and from other chemicals.
- TURPENTINE, FURNITURE AND PAINT STRIPPER, VARSOL, SOLVENTS, GASOLINE, LINSEED OIL, NAIL POLISH AND NAIL POLISH REMOVER, BBQ LIGHTER FLUIDS (flammable and toxic).
- WOOD PRESERVATIVE, WOOD STAINS, ANTI-FREEZE, GLUES, WINDOW CLEANERS, DISINFECTANTS, RAT AND MOUSE POISONS (toxic).
- OVEN CLEANERS, DRAIN CLEANERS (corrosive).
- OLD PROPANE TANKS (explosive).
- AEROSOL CONTAINERS (explosive, toxic and flammable). Empty containers as well.
- NEEDLES and SYRINGES. Clearly mark the container.
- PORTABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS
- FLORESCENT LIGHT BULBS/TUBES
- MERCURY-CONTAINING DEVICES (switches/thermometers)

DO NOT BRING (NOT ACCEPTED)

EXPLOSIVES, FIRE WORKS, AMMUNITION, BIOLOGICAL WASTE, PCB WASTE, WASTE FROM BUSINESSES, HELIUM OR FREON TANKS.
