Program helps eligible taxpayers with a simple tax situation & a modest income

Modest income

Based on the number of persons in your family, your total family income should be less than the amount shown in the chart.

Family size	Total family income
1 person	\$35,000
2 persons	\$45,000
3 persons	\$47,500
4 persons	\$50,000
5 persons	\$52,500
more than 5 persons	\$52,500 plus \$2,500 for each additional person

Simple tax situation

In general, your tax situation is simple if you have no income or if your income comes from these sources: employment income, pension benefits such as Canada Pension Plan, disability, employment insurance, social assistance, registered retirement savings plans (RRSP's) support payments scholarships, fellowships, bursaries or grants interest (under \$1,000)

Your tax situation **is not** simple if you: are self-employed or have employment expenses; have business or rental income and expenses; have capital gains or losses; filed for bankruptcy; are completing a tax return for a deceased person.
