**BY-LAW NO. 12 – 423**

**Being a By-Law to Authorize Signing of the Bark Lake Park Agreement with the  
Ministry of Natural Resources**

**WHEREAS** Section 20 of the Municipal Act 2001 c. 25 authorizes a municipality to enter into an agreement with a local body, and

**WHEREAS** it is the desire of Council for the Corporation of the Township of South Algonquin to enter into an agreement with the Ministry of Natural Resources, for the Township to manage and maintain the Bark Lake Park including the Public Boat Launch and Parking Areas situated on Crown Land being Lot 3 & 4, Concession 10 in the former geographic Township of Lyell, within the Township of South Algonquin.

**Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Algonquin enacts as follows:**

“That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign on behalf of the Corporation the Bark Lake Park Agreement being Schedule “A” attached”.

Any part of or other by-law that is inconsistent with or antedating this by-law is hereby repealed.

8. The Ministry of Natural Resources will not assume any other maintenance in regards to this access point.
9. The Township shall be responsible for undertaking any necessary water sampling programs as deemed appropriate by the local health unit for the purpose of determining the water condition for safe bathing.
10. The Township shall be responsible for removing any and all improvements should this agreement be terminated.

This agreement shall remain in effect for the period commencing January 01, 2012 and expiring December 31, 2020.
