BY-LAW NO. 14-469

Being a by-law to appoint a Lottery Licencing Officer

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, Chapter 25, contains provisions for Council to appoint such officers and employees as may be necessary for the purposes of the corporation;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to appoint a Lottery Licencing Officer;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Corporation of the Township of South Algonquin enacts as follows:

1. That the CAO/Clerk-Treasurer is hereby appointed Lottery Licencing Officer for the Township of South Algonquin
2. That the said CAO/Clerk-Treasurer shall hold office as council representative, and shall exercise all of the authority, powers and rights and shall perform all of the duties and obligations which by statute or by-law are or may be conferred or imposed upon the Lottery Licencing Officer.
3. That, pursuant to Section 288(4)(5) of the Municipal Act, 2001, Chapter 25, the Clerk may delegate in writing to any person other than a member of council, any of the Clerk's powers and duties under this or any other Act, and that in spite of this delegation, may continue to exercise the delegated powers and duties.
4. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon final passing thereof, and further that with the passage of this by-law, all other by-laws of the Township of South Algonquin appointing a Lottery Licencing Officer, are repealed.
