

CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH ALGONQUIN

BY-LAW NO. 16-505

Being a by-law to authorize the Mayor and CAO/Clerk Treasurer to sign the licensing agreement between the Ministry of Transportation Ontario and the Township of South Algonquin for the continued use of the lands and buildings located on Ministry lands formerly known as the Madawaska Patrol Yard located on the north side of Hwy 60 east of the intersection of Hwy 523/60

WHEREAS Section 20 of the *Municipal Act 2001 (as amended by Bill 130)* authorizes a municipality to enter into agreements, and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Corporation of the Township of South Algonquin to enter into a licensing agreement with the Ministry of Transportation Ontario for an interim licence for a one time fee of \$2.00(receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) to use the Ministry lands, buildings and equipment for administrative activities, storage of vehicles, equipment and supplies related to municipal operations for road maintenance.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South Algonquin enacts as follows:

“to authorize the Mayor and CAO/Clerk Treasurer to sign the licensing agreement between Ministry of Transportation Ontario and the Township of South Algonquin being “Schedule A” attached.”
