



The Provincial COVID 19 lockdown permits outdoor rinks to remain open under the following public health measures;

- Maximum 25 people on the ice at one time,
- Maximum 10 people in the rink building at one time

Users are responsible to not enter an area that has more than the maximum number of people outlined above.

The building can be used to;

- put your skates on or take them off
- use the washroom

To ensure that the rink can remain open users must wear a mask. If you are unable to wear a mask you are welcome to use the outdoor bench to change your skates.

In addition, we ask that you;

- 1) stay at home if you have symptoms; use the Covid-19 Self-Assessment Screening Tool at <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/>
- 2) avoid close contact with others stay at least 2 metres away
- 3) wash your hands regularly or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.

By following these simple steps, we can all do our part to reduce the spread of COVID-19 while enjoying a great season of fun!

If users are unwilling to follow these rules the Rinks will have to be closed.
