Township of South Algonquin hires Chief Administrative Officer, Clerk/Treasurer Bryan Martin

At a special council meeting on May 17, 2021, council received the recommendation of the Hiring Committee that the position of CAO/Clerk Treasurer be offered to Bryan Martin. Council passed a Resolution approving the Hiring Committee recommendation.

The Hiring Committee moderated by Lise Labine of Delfi Group, was comprised of Councillors Collins Chair of Human Resource Committee, Councillor Bongo, with CAO C/T Holly Hayes as a staff observer.

The interview process was comprised of a PXT Assessment which, is an online assessment that measures an individual's cognitive abilities, thinking styles, behaviors and interests. Candidates then were required to prepare a 10-minute presentation to the committee related to the implementation of the KPMG

efficiency review. Subsequently, the interviewees participated in an intensive, scored interview based on questions vetted by council.

Mr. Martin's interview was impressive, and his presentation was comprehensive and relevant. The Hiring Committee members indicated that they felt that Mr. Martin was the ideal candidate to continue to build on the achievements that council, staff and the municipality have realized during the tenure of our departing CAO Holly Hayes.

Mr. Martin assumed the position of Chief Administrative Official/Clerk Treasurer effective May 18, 2021.

It is with great pleasure that on behalf of Council, staff and the residents of South Algonquin, I welcome Bryan to the Township of South Algonquin.

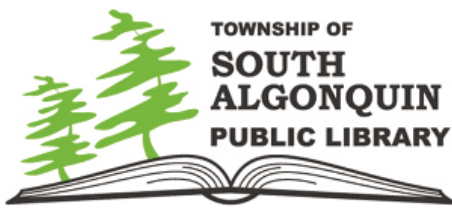
Pickle Ball

Web OPAC
