April 3 to October 16, 2024: Wednesdays 2:30 pm to 6:30 pm

Wednesday October 23 & 30 landfill site hours will be from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm

April 6 to October 26, 2024: Saturdays 8:00 am to 12:00 noon

Spring Cleanup Schedule: Both sites will be open 8:00 am to 3:30 pm for eight consecutive Saturdays commencing on the first weatherpermitting Saturday in April. Please visit the website for the dates.

Household Waste Collection Areas

SUNDAYS: From April 21 to October 14, 2024 the waste collection truck will be located at the entrance to North McKenzie Lake Road, locally known as Gunter's Mill from 9:30 am to 11:00 am and at the Aylen Lake Boat Launch from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. PLEASE NOTE: When Monday is a holiday, pickup will be on that holiday Monday, not the Sunday of that week.

TUESDAYS: Old 127, Hwy. 127 from the Old 127 south to the Sabine Ward including McGuey Rd, and the McKenzie Lake Road area, returning north on Hwy 127 to Old 127. McRae-Hay Lake Rd roadside collection will begin May 7 and end October 15.

WEDNESDAYS: The Village of Madawaska, Hwy 60 to the eastern boundary of the Township including Spectacle Lake Rd, Major Lake Rd and McCauley Lake Rd, Hwy 523 to the southern boundary of the Township. The waste collection truck will be located at the Aylen Lake Boat launch from 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm.

THURSDAYS: Hwy. 60 from the Village of Madawaska's western boundary to Hwy 127, south on Hwy 127 to Old 127/Hwy 127, returning north on Hwy 127 to Hwy 60, west on Hwy 60 to Whitney then the Village of Whitney including Hwy 60 to the western boundary of the Township, returning east on Hwy 60 to Madawaska.

BLUE BOX ITEMS NOW ACCEPTED AT BOTH **LANDFILL SITES**

Property owners can dispose of these items at the landfill site. Items will not be recycled when picked up by the waste collection truck. See the reverse side for the list of acceptable items

RECYCLE RIGHT: These items are acceptable in your recycling bin. Ensure all items are EMPTY AND CLEAN.

PLASTICS

WHAT EMPTY AND CLEAN Bottles and Jars (All Colors)



CARTONS

EMPTY AND CLEAN Boxed Food and Beverage Cartons



METAL

WHAT EMPTY AND CLEAN Aluminum and Steel Cans, Aluminum Foil











PAPER

WHAT Newspaper, Magazines, Printed Paper and Shredded Paper

Shredded paper in a paper bag. This is the only item that should be bagged













UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS - These items are NOT accepted with your recycling and require alternative handling







































AT THE LANDFILL SITE, WE RECYCLE, REDUCE, REUSE

Please see the Landfill Site Attendant prior to depositing material to ensure the proper location.

All Large Appliances: Place fridges and freezers in normal standing position and remove any latching or locking doors.

Aluminum: Aluminum is not magnetic (for example soft drink cans & cat food cans).

Batteries: Not car batteries.

Cardboard: Cardboard boxes need to be broken down. not thrown in whole.

Clean Wood: Only brush. unpainted or untreated wood.

Electronics: Anything with a cord.

Furniture: Fabric-covered furniture and mattresses.

Shredding: Most waste that is not hazardous, household, clean wood, reusable or recyclable (no food or food packaging).

Steel: All types.

Tires: Can be on rims.

Each landfill site has a reuse area where useful items can be deposited or taken home.

WASTE DISPOSAL AND FEES

NEW: A Waste Disposal Site Pass will be circulated with the interim tax notices in early March. This pass will be required from all residents, without exception, and must be shown to the attendant at both Airy and Madawaska landfill sites.

WASTE DISPOSAL FEES

Only waste generated from within the geographic boundaries of the Township of South Algonquin shall be deposited in the landfill site. Waste Disposal Site Pass or Demolition Permit must be provided.

Only domestic, construction and demolition waste, scrap metal/appliances and tires are accepted for disposal at the landfill sites. Hazardous waste, septic waste and liquid industrial waste are not accepted.

Brush, Wood Chips Half Ton Truck/Van with/without Small Trailer if brought in by resident. **NO CHARGE**

Tires on or off Rims NO CHARGE

Mattresses, box springs and fabric covered furniture with metal frames (couches, loveseats, sofa chairs etc.) \$10/piece

Fiber Glass/Wood Boats/Vessels Aluminum boats exempt \$5/foot

LANDFILL SITE ENTRY DURING NON-OPERATION HOURS

First entry (pre-approval required)

\$100 each

Additional same day entry (from time of first entry to last) \$50/hr

For your own protection, deliver the hazardous waste material labelled in the trunk of your car.

- DO NOT mix materials.
- All materials must be clearly marked.
- If the container is damaged, package the container in a plastic bag in order not to spill it during the journey to the collection site.

DO NOT BRING (NOT ACCEPTED)

EXPLOSIVES. FIRE WORKS. AMMUNITION. BIOLOGICAL WASTE. PCB WASTE, WASTE FROM BUSINESSES, HELIUM OR FREON TANKS.

Notice to Residents

- Please place household waste at the roadside on the scheduled day of collection. This will help deter birds and animals. (Property owners are responsible for picking up any waste that may get scattered along the roadside by birds and animals). The time of your roadside pick-up could be anytime between 7:00 am to 3:00 pm on your scheduled day.
- Residents are required to place household waste in garbage bags. Approved removable containers are permitted providing the household waste is in garbage bags (freezers or permanent containers are not acceptable).
- Residents, who store household waste in private bins or boxes will be required to remove the waste from these bins on the day of collection, put the waste in garbage bags and place them at the side of the nearest Township maintained road or public highway. Private bins must be located on private property outside of the obvious road allowance.

TRANSPORTING WASTE

• Residents are required to secure and cover loads to avoid debris from falling off onto municipal roads and highways.
