Over **65%** of all carbon monoxide deaths and injuries in Ontario occur in **homes**.

Ensure **all** fuel-burning appliances and vents in your home are inspected annually. Find a registered contractor at [COsafety.ca](https://www.ontario.ca/en/gov/service/cosafety).

Install and regularly test carbon monoxide alarms.
