

HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION AREAS

SUNDAYS: From May 18 to October 12, 2026 the waste collection truck will be located at the entrance to North McKenzie Lake Road, locally known as Gunter's Mill from 9:30 am to 11:00 am and at the Aylen Lake Boat Launch from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

PLEASE NOTE: When Monday is a holiday, pickup will be on that holiday Monday, not the Sunday of that week.

TUESDAY: Old 127, Hwy. 127 from the Old 127 south to the Sabine Ward including McGuey Rd, McKenzie Lake Rd area, returning north on Hwy 127 to Old 127.

WEDNESDAY: The Village of Madawaska, Hwy 60 to the eastern boundary of the Township including Spectacle Lake Rd, Major Lake Rd & McCauley Lake Rd, Hwy 523 to the southern boundary of the Township. From 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. the waste collection truck will be located at the Aylen Lake Boat Launch, 1706 Aylen Lake Rd. as long as the weather permits then it will move to the corner of Aylen Lake Rd. and North Aylen Lake Rd.

THURSDAY: Hwy. 60 from the Village of Madawaska's western boundary to Hwy 127, south on Hwy 127 to Old 127/Hwy 127, returning north on Hwy 127 to Hwy 60, west on Hwy 60 to Whitney then the Village of Whitney including Hwy 60 to the western boundary of the Township, returning east on Hwy 60 to Madawaska.

OPERATION SCHEDULE

AIRY: 462 Nipissing Road, Whitney

LYELL: 6319 Highway 523, Madawaska

April 1 to October 28, 2026: Wednesdays 2:30 pm to 6:30 pm

April 4 to October 31, 2026: Saturdays 8:00 am to 12:00 noon Spring Cleanup Schedule: Both sites will be open 8:00 am to 3:30 pm for eight consecutive Saturdays commencing on the first weather permitting Saturday in April.

The dates will be circulated on our website and on our Facebook page closer to the dates.

April 19 to October 11 2026: Sundays 10:00 am to 2:00 pm

As of January 2026, bag tags are required for any household waste exceeding the two-bag limit per pickup. Each household is permitted two bags per collection. Additional bags must have a bag tag attached.

Bag tags cost \$2.00 each and are available at the following locations:

- Township Office – 7 Third Ave, Whitney
- The Algonquin Lunch Bar – 29553 Highway 60, Whitney
- Madawaska Country Store – 252003 Highway 60, Madawaska
- Lake St. Peter Building & Supply – 2717 Highway 127, Lake St. Peter

Residents may also bring household waste directly to the landfill at no charge.

- For your own protection, deliver the hazardous waste material labelled.
- DO NOT mix materials.
 - All materials must be clearly marked.
 - If the container is damaged, package the container in a plastic bag in order not to spill it during the journey to the collection site.

DO NOT BRING (NOT ACCEPTED)
EXPLOSIVES, FIRE WORKS, AMMUNITION, BIOLOGICAL WASTE, PCB WASTE, WASTE FROM BUSINESSES, HELIUM OR FREON TANKS.

WASTE DISPOSAL AND FEES

A Waste Disposal Site Pass must be shown to the attendant to dispose of waste at both landfill sites. If you are new to the township and require a pass please contact the office. Replacement passes can be purchased for \$10.00 at the township office. Please note your waste pass does not expire.

Only waste generated from within the geographic boundaries of the Township of South Algonquin shall be deposited in the landfill site. Waste Disposal Site Pass or Demolition Permit must be provided. Only domestic, construction and demolition waste, scrap metal/appliances and tires are accepted for disposal at the landfill sites. Hazardous waste, septic waste and liquid industrial waste are not accepted.

Acceptable Items

RECYCLE RIGHT: These items are acceptable in your recycling bin. Ensure all items are empty and clean.

PLASTICS

WHAT EMPTY AND CLEAN Plastic Bottles, Containers and Cups



GLASS

WHAT EMPTY AND CLEAN Bottles and Jars (All Colors)



CARTONS

WHAT EMPTY AND CLEAN Boxed Food and Beverage Cartons, Paper Cups



METAL

WHAT EMPTY AND CLEAN Aluminum and Steel Cans, Aluminum Foil



PAPER

WHAT Newspaper, Magazines, Printed Paper and Shredded Paper
HOW Shredded paper in a paper bag. This is the only item that should be bagged



CARDBOARD

WHAT FLATTENED AND DRY Cardboard



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS - These items are NOT accepted with your recycling and require alternative handling



Organic, kitchen, yard and animal waste.

Hazardous waste like paint, gas or aerosol cans, sharp objects, electronics and batteries.

Scrap metal, wires and cables, home and construction waste.

Napkins, paper towels and food soiled cardboard.

Styrofoam™ packaging materials and takeout food/ beverage containers.

Textiles, housewares, windows, ceramics, and other reusable items.

Large plastic products like bins or trays, pouches, plastic bags, and toys.

Diapers and personal hygiene products.

Notice to Residents

- Please place household waste at the roadside on the scheduled day of collection. This will help deter birds and animals. (Property owners are responsible for picking up any waste that may get scattered along the roadside by birds and animals). The time of your road side pick-up could be anytime between 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on your scheduled day.
- Residents are required to place household waste in garbage bags. Approved removable containers permitted providing the household waste is in garbage bags. (Freezers or permanent containers are not acceptable).
- Residents, who store household waste in private bins or boxes will be required to remove the waste from these bins on the day of collection, put the waste in garbage bags and place them at the side of the nearest Township maintained road or public highway. Private bins must be located on private property outside of the obvious road allowance.

Please note: Non-household waste will not be collected at the curb. These items must be taken directly to the landfill sites for proper disposal.

WE RECYCLE. REDUCE. REUSE.

All Large Appliances: Place fridges and freezers in normal standing position and remove any latching or locking doors.

Aluminum: Aluminum is not magnetic (for example soft drink cans & cat food cans).

Steel: All types.

Batteries: Not car batteries

Cardboard: Cardboard boxes need to be broken down, not thrown in whole.

Clean wood: Only brush, unpainted or untreated wood.

Electronics: Anything with a cord.

Tires: Can be on rims.

Shredding: Most waste that is not hazardous, household, clean wood, reusable or recyclable (no food or food packaging).

Each landfill site has a reuse area where useful items can be deposited or taken home.
